



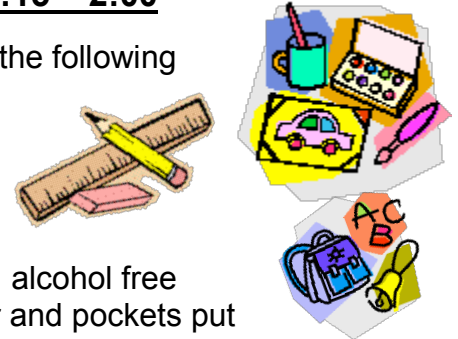
## Dear Mrs. Morse's Kindergarten Parents,

Welcome to CAPE. We are looking forward to a wonderful year with your child.

Parent's are asked to come with their child on the first day of school, Wednesday, September 3, 2008. Parents will stay for an orientation meeting to last approximately 60 minutes. Children will stay for the normal kindergarten day: **8:15 – 2:00**

For the first day of school, we are asking if you can please donate the following supplies:

- Crayola primary color washable marking pen set
- Crayola pastel color washable marking pen set
- 1 each 4oz. bottle of Elmer's glue
- 2 large boxes of tissue unscented
- 2 large boxes of baby wipes (1 can be a refill) unscented, alcohol free
- 1 each 1-inch 3 ring white binder with clear acetate cover and pockets put name inside
- 2 each 2-inch 3 ring white binders with clear acetate cover and pockets put name inside
- 1 box of 24 regular sized crayons with child's name on outside
- 8 glue sticks
- 2 white plastic hooks for over the rail-can be gotten at B&B
- 3 dry erase markers, low odor-mixed colors
- 3 skinny dry erase markers, low odor-mixed colors
- Students with last name beginning with **A-L**: 1 ream or 50 pkg of cardstock white 65 lb. weight and 1 of bright  pastel color Xerox paper all 8-1/2" x 11"
- Students with last name beginning with **M-Z**: 1 package of 50 or more cardstock mix bright colors 65 lb. weight and 1 of bright color Xerox paper all 8-1/2" x 11"
- 2 poly envelopes approx 9"x12" side opening Velcro closure 1 red 1 blue (can be found easiest at Target), (Please do NOT put your student's name on them)
- 5 heavy duty 2 pocket portfolio (not poly) with 3 fasteners, (Please do NOT put your student's name on them)
- 1 large backpack labeled with child's name. No roll carts please.
- 1 lunch bag or box labeled on front with child's name.
- 1 snack bag or box labeled on front with child's name/needs to be different from lunch as they go on different carts.



Your child will need to bring a snack and lunch in separate containers for this first day. Children are to bring snack and lunch for the first two weeks while they learn the procedures. After that your child can buy lunch if that is an option.

Also, it is very helpful for your child to have a **backpack the first day** to place his/her papers, homework and newsletters at the end of the day. This will help develop your child's sense of responsibility.

Please **label EVERYTHING** personal that your child brings to school: jacket, sweaters, books and the things for his/her backpack.
