

CAPE LOCKER USE AGREEMENT NOTIFICATION

2009-2010 School Year

To All Students and Parents:

This letter announces and explains the school locker policy for CAPE Charter School. This policy applies to all students.

CAPE Charter School:

- Provides lockers for students during the school year. You may keep only your personal belongings in the locker.
- Each locker requires a durable combination lock that will be provided by CAPE Charter School. Lockers must be kept locked using only the lock provided. The combination to the locker will be on file in the office.
- The combination lock is property of CAPE Charter School and damaged or lost locks must be replaced by students at a cost of \$24.00 per lock.
- Students are responsible for **all** contents of the locker as well as the condition of the locker itself (inside and out). Lockers must be kept free of graffiti or other damage. No permanent marking allowed in locker (this includes stickers). The cost of any repairs to damaged or permanently marked lockers will be the responsibility of the student.
- Students use the lockers at their own risk. The school is not responsible for any loss of property kept in the locker.
- You cannot keep anything illegal in your school locker such as:
 - Drugs
 - Alcohol
 - Stolen property
 - Anything that could be used as a weapon
 - Anything deemed by the school or police to be a danger
 - Anything else illegal to possess
- Students should not have an expectation of privacy for their locker. Lockers are the property of CAPE Charter School. CAPE Charter School reserves the rights to open, search and inspect your school locker without notice to you.
- If a CAPE Charter School employee searches your locker and finds anything listed in section 5 in your locker, a CAPE employee may confiscate those items, secure them and use them as evidence for school discipline. A CAPE employee may turn those items over to law enforcement for possible criminal investigation and charges.
- All students and parents will read and sign this letter of notification.

I acknowledge that I have read and understood the above notification. I understand that I have no right to privacy for my school locker and the contents of my school locker.
